Standards of Permit:

1. If you are targeting any species managed commercially or recreationally, exact species and estimated number and total weight of collections must be specified. No sharks may be collected without a special permit.
2. A copy of your collection permit must be available for presentation by any designated project personnel to any Police Officer, during all phases of collection activities.
3. A copy of any **activity report or results** from your project must be submitted to the VMRC annually.
4. All bycatch and incidental catch must be returned to the water immediately after collecting the necessary information.
5. Any protected resource interactions (sea turtles, marine mammals, and sturgeon) should be reported to VMRC within 24 hours with the disposition of the animal (released unharmed, released injured, or dead).

6. Applicant agrees to allow their data to be used by VMRC in presentations regarding the permit.
7. Applicant is required to allow VMRC observers to accompany trips with advance notice.
8. Applicant may be required to maintain a logbook of activities, catch, and observations.
