RE: COMMERCIAL SCUP PER TRIP POSSESSION LIMIT FOR THE 2022 WINTER II PERIOD (OCTOBER 1 – DECEMBER 31)

On Friday September 30, 2022, the National Marine Fisheries Service announced the adjustment to the 2022 Winter II commercial scup quota and per-trip Federal landing limit. The Winter II period will run from October 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022. During this period, it shall be unlawful for any person to possess aboard any vessel or to land in Virginia any amount of scup totaling more than 24,000 pounds.
