I. ASMFC Public Hearing on Draft Addendum IV to Amendment 6 to the Atlantic Striped Bass Interstate Fishery Management Plan

Mr. Mike Waine of the Atlantic States Marine Fisheries Commission presented the
Draft Addendum and all the possible management options regarding a reduction in
harvest for the striped bass fishery. Mr. Waine then took comments and questions
from the public and the Finfish Management Advisory Committee. The majority
present favored developing reference points for the coastal and bay stocks; the
majority also favored a three year timeline chosen to implement the reduction.
Those present also supported taking any form of reduction from the 2012 harvest.
The majority of comments made were in favor of implementing the reduction of 7%
each year over a period of three years (Option D). The majority of comments made
also favored status quo with the existing commercial size limits. Mr. Waine told the

Committee and members of the public that the period for public comment on the Addendum is open until 5pm on September 30, 2014.
