- B) 2013 Knights of Columbus Annual Kids Fishing Day (Year 26th). Greg Brown, \$7,453.13 Support
- C) 2013 Hope House & Oak Grove Nursing Home Fishing Excursions and Clinics. Joseph Stephenson; Paul Anderson, Great Bridge Fisherman's Association. **\$5,350 Support**
- D) 2013 Youth Developmental "Hooked on Fishing" Adventure (Year 6).
