<b>DESCRIPTIVE TITLE OF PROJECT:</b>  Sixth Annual VCBA Youth Fishing Adventure Day							
<b>PROJECT SUMMARY:</b>  The event begins with educational topics taught by the individual Captains. The topics will include one or more of the following: basic first aid, boat safety, Virginia fishing regulations, fish conservation, and boat navigation.  We depart the Marina and each child is coached on how to fish with their own fishing rod and reel. Our day concludes with a picnic lunch, awards and displays/demonstrations by vendors and educators.  This year's goal is to take 200 or more youngsters from multiple resource groups, and their chaperones, for a day on the Bay.							
<b>EXPECTED BENEFITS:</b>  We instill a deep appreciation of Virginia's natural resources and the important role each person has in conserving those resources. We use current information available from the state to educate each youth. We try to use the fishing rules to connect the adherences to these rules to conservation. We demonstrate that we operate our Charter business in compliance with the rules to protect the environment, conserve Bay fisheries, and provide a safe fishing experience. Our goal is to educate these youngsters about how important it is to respect and preserve the marine environment and to demonstrate the joy of recreational fishing.
