For the past several years the outings have had from 40 to 80 children, ages 3 to 15. The average attendance is 55 children per outing for a total of 110.	The average cost per participating child is about \$25.25.

BRIEF EVENT PLAN SUMMARY:

Children from ages three to fifteen years are brought to the outing by an accompanying adult. The children are provided with a rod, reel, line, bottom tackle, and tee shirt. They are then taken to the pier by club members and accompanying adult, taught to bait the hook (and about a variety of baits), to safely drop the line overboard, retrieve, identify and measure fish

and to release fish. After the allotted fishing time is over the children are given lunch, and modest trophies and certificates are awarded for the three longest fish. Group photos are taken and fun is had by all. Mr. Johnny W. Conquest of Hallwood, VA, is the fishing and conservation educational outing coordinator.
