BRIEF EVENT PLAN SUMMARY: The project will be held in August 2017. The Norfolk Anglers Club is working with Norfolk's East Ocean View Community Center and its Summer Program to identify neighborhood youth to participate in a ½ day morning fishing trip on a head boat. These young people would participate in the fun of catching fish and the benefit of being on a head boat with knowledgeable NAC volunteers and Community Center staff who will provide fishing and ecological information about the Chesapeake Bay and discuss the Virginia Junior Awards Program. We project 45 to 50 youth (ages from 9 to 14), plus 15 chaperones to participate in the event. The participants will be provided free transportation to and from the Community Center to the head boat location. The head boat will provide the bait and fishing equipment and NAC will provide the drinks and snacks for the trip. Subsequent to the trip, NAC volunteers will prepare a picnic for the participants at the East Ocean View Community Center.

DETAILED BUDGET FOR NORFOLK ANGLERS CLUB HEAD BOAT PROJECT (2017)

Projected for 65 youth and volunteers

Participation will include 45 - 50 youth, 4 – 5 Community Center staff and 10 – 15 NAC volunteers (5 will prepare the picnic). VMRC requested funds - \$1200; projected youth (\$26.67/ participant for 45 children), \$24.00 /participant for 50 children).

Head Boat - \$975.00

½ day Bay trip that includes bait and head boat rods and reels.

Food - \$320.00

Hot Dogs, Hamburgers, Buns, Macaroni and Cheese, Coleslaw, Chips, Doritos, Lettuces, Tomatoes, Slice Cheese, Watermelon, Cookies, Classic Mix Chips (individual bags), Mustard, Ketchup, Relish, and Mayo.

Drinks \$150.00

Individual Hawaiian Punch, Apple Juice, and Caprisun Packs; Soda, and Bottled Water.

Plastic, Paper, and Grill Supplies - \$90.00

Aluminum Foil; Serving Pans; Spatula and Serving Prongs and Spoons, Napkins; Plastic Forks, Knives, and Spoons; Plates and Cups; Paper Towels; Garbage Bags; Charcoal and Lighter.

Transportation – No Cost

Transportation (Vans) will be provided by Norfolk’s East Ocean View Community Center and the Ocean View Fishing Pier at no charge. Also, if needed NAC volunteers will transport youth to head boat location.

Other Supplies and Equipment – No Cost

Community Center will provide dining facilities and the use of its grill. Ice will be provided on the boat for drinks and at the picnic by NAC.
