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Dear Shellfish Dealer:

The National Shellfish Sanitation Program guidelines require training and education programs for all shellfish harvesters and certified dealers. This training program is currently being implemented in Virginia and is required for <u>all</u> 2015 shellfish permits and licenses with Virginia Marine Resource Commission (VMRC) and the Virginia Department of Health (VDH), Division of Shellfish Sanitation (DSS). The training is free and will be required every two years in Virginia. Completion of the training is a pre-requisite for 2015 licensing and certification. The intent is to increase the awareness of temperature control and food handling practices for shellfish to minimize the growth of *Vibrio* bacteria.

The Shellfish Dealer training module is now available online. If you attended the in person training this past year (or at the Aquaculture Conference in 2013), or you are planning on participating in one of the December 2014 in person sessions, you do not have to complete the online training module for shellfish dealers.

This educational requirement for shellfish dealers is in addition to HACCP requirements. Shellfish dealers <u>must</u> obtain this training within 90 days of initial licensing in order to be listed on the interstate certified shellfish shippers list (ICSSL). At a minimum, one individual from each shellfish dealer operation shall obtain the required training.

To access the online training, you will need to go to the website, https://va.train.org. You must have a valid email address to complete this online course. On the website home page for TRAIN, you will see on the top of the page a link entitled "How to create a TRAIN account". You will need to follow the instructions once you open the link to create your account which will involve a unique user ID and password. Included in this mailing is also a reference document to assist with setting up your account. Once you have created your account, you can locate the Shellfish Dealer Course by either searching the course name or entering the unique course ID number:

In following the course flow, everyone will need to listen and view the first section of slides. After the introductory period, you may select what type of shellfish dealer you are based on your certification number (shucker packer -SP, shellstock shipper-SS, Repacker-RP or Reshipper-RS), and complete only that section. For example, if your dealer certification number is VA 000SS, then you would need to select the Shellstock Shipper segment. On the next to the last slide you will see a blank certificate. If you wish to have a paper certificate, you will need to type in your name and print and/or save your certificate from that page while you have the course open and running. Instructions on how to do both are on the included set of instructions. Once you complete the course, we will have a record here in the Richmond VDH DSS central office. Please allow one hour for the training.

The Harvester Training is required prior to purchasing 2015 VMRC shellfish licenses and permits. It can be completed online. The Harvester Training can be found online at: https://webapps.mrc.virginia.gov/public/training/register.php.

Please note all questions related to the harvester training should be directed to VMRC.

*Before moving on - look on the right hand side of the page. Select the checkbox to receive emails from TRAIN. You will not receive SPAM email from this training database. Email addresses will be used to confirm course completion and to disseminate information from the VDH Shellfish office.

GROUP SELECTION:

Next to "State Portal" Select the box labeled "Select Groups"

From the dropdown menu, select "Not a Virginia Certified EMS Provider"

Select "State Agency" and under department, select "Department of Health"

CHOOSING A ROLE:

Scroll to the bottom of the page and check the box next to "Other"

Tab over to the right-hand column and type in "shellfish dealer"
