All permit holders will be responsible for complying with all VMRC restrictions and requirements contained in Regulation 4VAC 20-720-10 ET SEQ. and any other VMRC regulations and laws in the Code of Virginia, which pertain to the harvesting of oysters. This sheet is not a license, but a free permit to harvest in the James River Hand Scrape Area and Thomas Rock Hand Scrape Area. In addition to this permit, you must have a current Commercial Registered Fisherman License and possess a current oyster gear license and have paid the Oyster Resource User Fee (\$300.00) required by the Code of Virginia for the harvest of oysters in these areas. You must report your daily harvest on Mandatory Reporting Forms, as required by the Code of Virginia and VMRC Regulation 4 VAC 20-610-10, Et Seq.

BEFORE HARVESTERS CAN SELL THEIR CATCH FOR DIRECT CONSUMPTION THEY ARE REQUIRED TO OBTAIN A SHELLFISH SHIPPER CERTIFICATION FROM THE VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, DIVISION OF SHELLFISH SANITATION IN RICHMOND, VIRGINIA (804-371-6431).
