

### Rules

- All anglers 15 years old, or younger, are eligible; the program will start January 1st and the 16th birthday of eligible anglers must not occur prior to this date. There are no entry fees.
- To qualify for a Virginia Junior Angler Award, an angler must catch and release six different eligible species of saltwater fish on rod and reel, while fishing in the marine waters of Virginia or while fishing in the Chesapeake Bay or the Atlantic Ocean on a boat leaving from and returning to a Virginia port. There are no minimum size limits.
- The angler must complete the reverse side of this card with all required information, including the name of a person who witnessed each catch-and-release, and mail it to the office of the Virginia Saltwater Fishing Tournament, 2600 Washington Ave., 3rd Floor, Newport News, Virginia 23607, prior to December 31st. All anglers fulfilling these requirements will receive a certificate suitable for framing recognizing their accomplishments.
