WORK DESCRIPTION: Full-time position managing a broad spectrum of fisheries resource programs, fisheries staff, and organizational and administrative functions. Plans, directs, initiates, and implements data and information input and retrieval programs. Develops fisheries management plans, in conjunctions with other Fisheries Management professionals. Participates in the initiation and implementation of fishery regulations, and provides detailed written and oral evaluations on issues before the Commission. Responsible for department expenditures, assisting in the administration of grants, personnel selection, and managing subordinate supervisors for various fishery programs. Serves as a liaison with the fishing industries.

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS: Experience in a leadership role managing multiple on-site and off-site programs and staff with diverse functions; developing and executing plans; preparing and presenting briefings and position statements on fisheries issues to various advisory groups and regulatory authorities, to include giving testimony on such issues during public hearings; assisting in recreational and commercial research of fisheries-related issues and making recommendations for changes and improvements in the recreational and commercial fishing industries to the Division Assistant Chief and Chief, and conducting public hearings. Ideal candidate must have knowledge of the Virginia fishing industries, to include: major harvesting methods, marketing infrastructure, and important commercial and recreational finfish and shellfish species; be an experienced user of Microsoft Windows programs to include proficiency with customizing and managing databases in Microsoft Access and Excel. Must be knowledgeable of statistical analysis and stock assessment methods, and have excellent oral and written communication skills. Prefer degree in fisheries sciences, resource management, or related fields if study.
