## 2014 Kiwanis Fishing Clinic

**PROJECT SUMMARY:**

1 The objective of this project is to identify and educate at Risk Children of Virginia by exposing and instructing them in the recreational aspects of saltwater fishing. The Kiwanis Clubs of Capitol District will provide the general management of the event as well as the hands on fishing experience. Our intent is to educate approximately 250 youths on conservation ethics, local saltwater fishing with the resultant expectation of lifelong knowledge and participation.

The primary plan is to have each child proceed through a series of educational stations, which increase their knowledge, and appreciation of our natural aquatic resources. Once the educational stations have been completed, a hands-on fishing experience follows by the Kiwanis Clubs. Out on the James River Fishing Pier, Children will be given a rod/reel, tackle as well as instruction on the safe and appropriate use of the equipment. Lunch is provided to the children and adult volunteers.

**EXPECTED BENEFITS:**

The purpose of this project is to educate children as well as provide them tools that can be used again. Keeping the rods/reels by the children is expected to enhance recreational opportunities among the children as well as promote marine safety, environmental program involvement, and identification of edible and non-edible fish specie. Also, we will teach catch and release to protect fish species population
