Invitations are extended to 250 At-Risk youth to attend an event at Buckroe Fishing Pier where volunteers guide them through educational booths where they learn about marine life and local species of fish they may encounter. Each child is given a rod/reel, tackle, T-Shirt, hat and lunch. Experienced angling volunteers work with the kids to teach them how to fish and focus on safety. After the education portion of the clinic, they do hands on fishing, then all children volunteers and chaperones have lunch off the pier. In addition to the 250 participants, there will be approximately 75 chaperones and another 50-75 pier angling volunteers. This project is a combination of efforts by both Hampton Parks & Rec as well as Newport News Parks & Rec. This assures our goal of achieving a significant cross section from our community.
