If there is no qualification on the leaseholders estate (meaning no one has qualified by the Clerk of the Circuit Court) within one year of the date of death, a transfer can then be executed by all of the lawful heirs within the next six months thereafter. To obtain any oyster ground lease (or interest therein) a person, persons, and/or corporation(s) must meet the legal requirements to hold oyster lease ground in the Commonwealth of Virginia (28.2-604).

\*For riparian leases, the lease must be in the exact same name as the adjoining upland property. Transfer of the adjoining highland property shall require a transfer of the riparian assignment within eighteen months after the transfer of the highland ownership (28.2-601).
