#### \*\*\*HOW TO INDICATE YOU WOULD LIKE TO SPEAK VIA YOUTUBE CHAT:

- 1. Log in with your Gmail or YouTube account on the YouTube page (<u>https://www.youtube.com/user/vamarineresources/live</u>).
- 2. When the live stream begins, the chat box will appear on the right side of the screen.
- 3. Type your FULL NAME and that you would like to speak during the public comment period.
- 4. Staff will collate names prior to the public comment period and hand them off to the Commissioner.
- 5. Since YouTube is delayed by 8 to 10 seconds, MAKE SURE YOU LISTEN FOR YOUR NAME ON THE PUBLIC CALL AUDIO. Mute your computer audio when you begin speaking so there is no feedback and the Commissioners can hear you clearly.
